

The very basics of using Google Earth for finding and using images.


TO SEARCH THE MAP

1. To search for a location, I need to use the <u>search block</u> and click the <u>magnifying glass</u>



TO NAVIGATE THE MAP

- 1. I can navigate the map by using the navigation buttons at the top right of the screen
 - 2. The navigation buttons appear when I move the **mouse** over them.
 - 3. Label the navigation buttons...



BOOKMARK A LOCATION

- 1. Browse to a location using the **search** and **navigation buttons**
- 2. Click the **Placemark** button (push pin) above the map
- 3. The **Push Pin** will appear on the map
- <u>Drag</u> the Placemark to the location, <u>name</u>
 and click <u>OK</u>
- 5.The bookmark will appear under the **Places** block

TAKE A SCREEN SHOT OF A LOCATION

- 1. Browse to a location using the **search** and **navigation buttons**
- 2. Go to Edit: Copy: Copy Image
- 3. A screen shot is invisibly held on the computer clipboard
- 4. Open any application (Email, Word, PowerPoint, etc) and Paste screen shot
- 5. Screen shot will appear after Pasted
